Playing music allows :

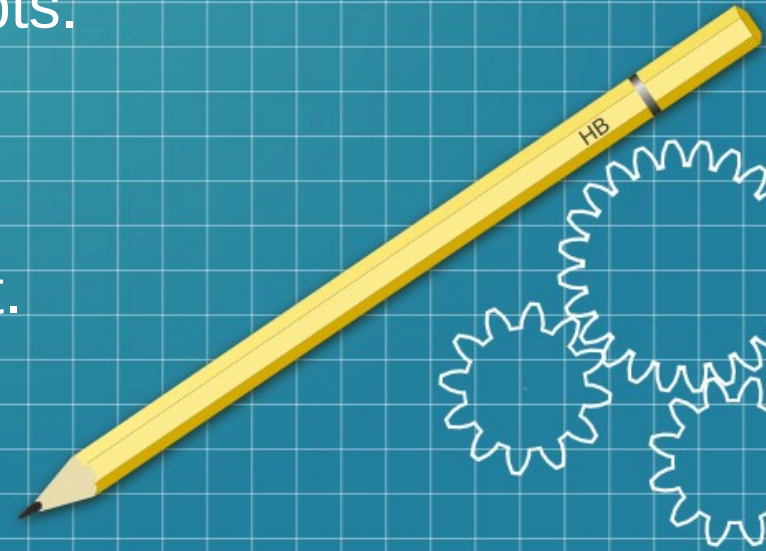
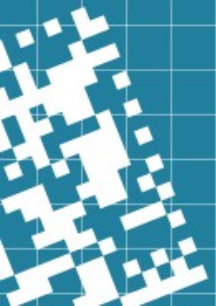
- To densify mind.

Scientific design


His scientific field :
